

# Cost of High-Pressure Folding Containers for Bridges

How can a foldable container reduce the cost of storage?

The satisfaction of such conditions and the eventual adoption of the foldable container by the market would reduce the operation costs by 50% to 60%, the storage space in yard and depot by 80% and CO<sub>2</sub> emissions by 20% [8,12].

What is a foldable container?

It is, therefore, suitable for use by shipping lines and terminals. Foldable containers save up to 75% space and costs (50-60%). One standard container takes up as much space as four foldable ones. In addition, they are more environmentally friendly. The transport of foldable containers generates 37% less carbon dioxide.

How much does it cost to reposition an intermodal shipping container?

The intermodal shipping container is 70 years old. Over the years it has been refined but ownership costs have increased. For example, this year, the annual operating prices have ranged between \$25,000 to \$40,000 to reposition an empty container.

Why should you choose a foldable container?
