What is our Solar System?

What is the smallest planet in the Solar System?

Let's begin with the first planet of the solar system like we always should. Mercury is the smallest planet out of the 8 planets in our solar system and also the closest planet to the sun. Mercury is written in Japanese with two kanji letters (水) and it's pronounced in Japanese as "Suisei".

What does "planet" mean in Japanese?

It makes perfect sense since stars are just planets, and sometimes they are bigger than the sun itself. Even "Planet" (惑星) in Japanese literally means false star.
